

# PRONOMS et DETERMINANTS



- Un **pronom** remplace un nom.
- Un **déterminant** détermine le nom (et accompagne donc toujours un nom).
- Le pronom personnel sujet se place directement devant ou derrière le verbe.
- Le pronom personnel complément se place toujours derrière le groupe sujet-verbe.
- Le déterminant possessif se place toujours devant le nom qu'il accompagne.
